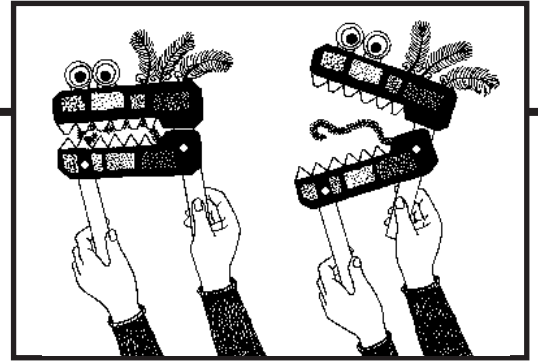


MONSTER CHOMPER



card discs + wiggly eyes
2 making eyes

thin corrugated card
1 head and jaw shapes

feathers

6 adding hairy bits

strong joints

3 fixing the legs

furry craft stem

5 snaky tongue

loose swivel action

brass fasteners

4 fixing the jaw

textured papers

7 colour and decoration

coloured markers

recycled card

Use corrugated card from old boxes - the same thickness as pizza boxes. Cereal boxes are a bit too thin

It should be stiff but easy to cut out

you will need

Tools:

colour markers, pencil, scissors, solid glue stick, sticky tape, stapler

materials:

thin corrugated card (like a pizza box)
2 brass fasteners

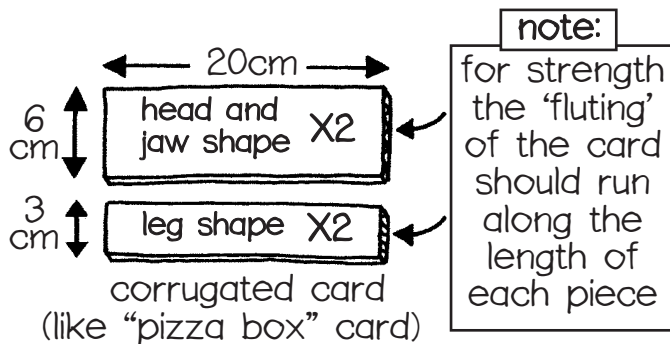
decoration:

pipe cleaners or furry craft stems, wiggly eyes, feathers, colourful decorative paper

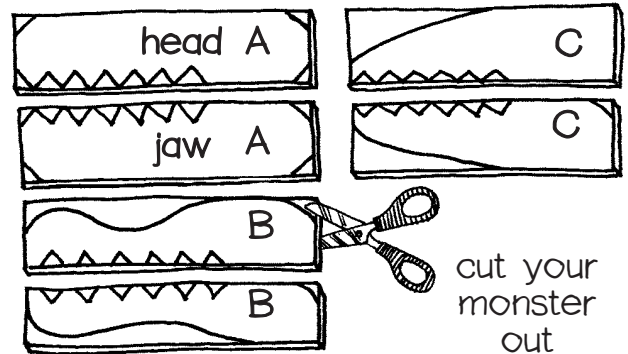
thinking by making

MONSTER CHOMPER

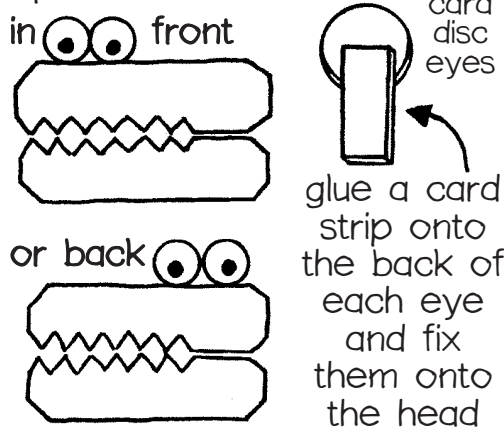
- 1** Cut out 4 pieces of card: 2 for the head and jaw, and 2 for the legs.



design a monster shape and draw it on the card (like A, B or C below)

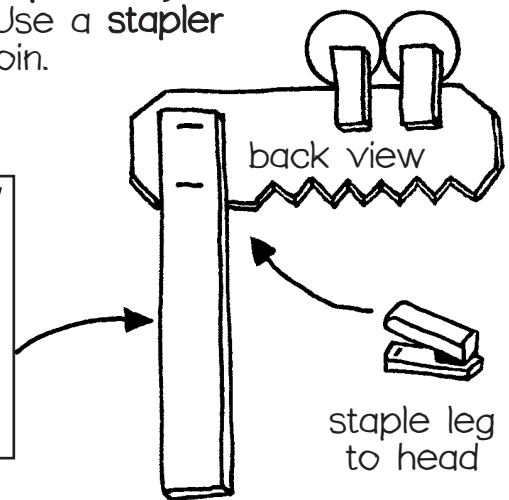


- 2** Cut out 2 card discs for eyes and decide where to put them.

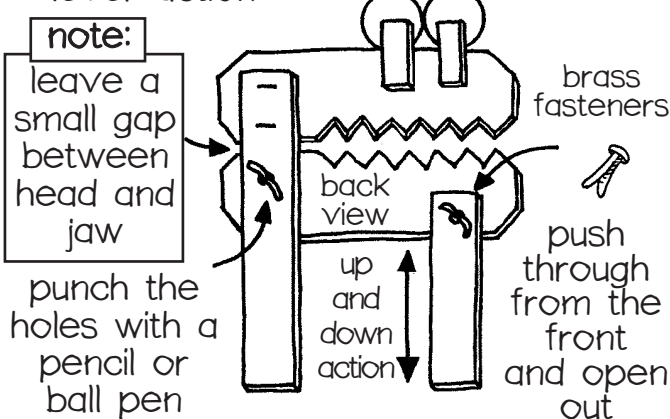


- 3** Fix one leg shape firmly onto the back of the head. Use a stapler for a strong join.

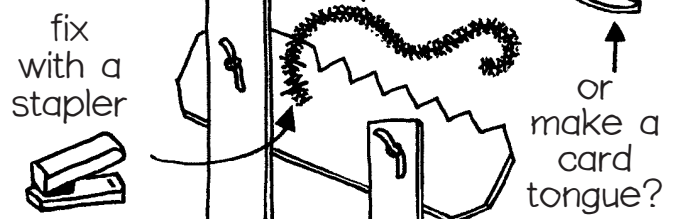
note:
the leg should not bend.
You can stiffen it with a flat lolly stick or extra card



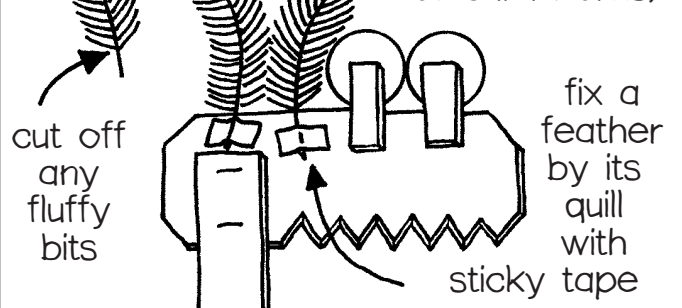
- 4** Fix the lower jaw to both legs with brass fasteners to create the swivel lever action



- 5** Make a tongue from a furry craft stem



- 6** Make hairy bits with feathers. (or cut and fix a pair of card horns)



- 7** Colour and decorate all over with felt markers and pieces of textured paper. Add wiggly eyes too?
